

The Page County Board of Supervisors met in session on this 9th day of January 2019, with Alan Armstrong, Chuck Morris, and Jon Herzberg present. Present from the public were Bill Billings, Lyle Palmer, Brenda Esaias, Carl Sonksen, and Jessica Erdman.

The compensation board meeting was held at J's Pizza.

The board discussed the opioid education grant. Bill Billings met with the board. He discussed opioid addiction, drug testing protocols, and how this impacts employees and law enforcement. Page County was chosen because the population is over 15,000, and there are two hospitals within the county. Morris reached out to Smisek with Ahlers & Cooney and discussed the legalities of the contract. The memorandum of understanding addresses these issues.
