- Limited access to the public. We ask that as much communication be conducted by phone or e-mail. Appointments can be scheduled by contacting our office at the above listed number.

Parks/Camp Grounds

At this point, all of our county parks and campgrounds are open and we are encouraging the public to continue to enjoy the outdoors and use our facilities. We ask that the public continue to follow guidelines and recommendations that have been put out by public health entities and the CDC. The following bullets are specific to our parks:

- Bathroom and shower facilities are currently closed due to normal seasonal closing. However, these will remain closed through April 15th at which time the situation will be re-assessed.
- Please limit groups sizes to under 10 people while in the parks. For camping, please limit your party to 6 or less.
- Try to maintain distance between yourself and other park visitors as recommended by public health officials.
- If possible, please leave a camping site open between yourself and others who are not in your party. If this is not possible, please take into consideration the health and boundaries of your fellow campers.

Shooting Range at Pierce Creek

The public shooting range will continue to operate on it's normal schedule (weather dependent), but will be limited to 10 people at a time. Once this limit is reached, individuals will have to wait outside of the range area until an opening is available. This will be handled by on-site range officers.

Shelters

All of our shelters will be open and reservations are being accepted. However, current declarations issued on March 17, 2020 by the State of Iowa, limits the group size to 10 or less. Refunds are available for parties that have already reserved the shelters.

Please understand that as conditions change, our policies may as well. It is our hope that with individual responsibility and safe practices, we will be able to keep our parks and campgrounds open throughout the season. Please feel free to contact our office if you have any questions!
