

### Treasurer's Office Update

Governor Reynolds Proclamation of Disaster Emergency signed on July 24<sup>th</sup> impacts many of the services provided at the Treasurer's office.

The proclamation sections related to property taxes were extended through Friday, July 31, 2020.

The sections related to driving with an expired license were extended through August 23, 2020.

The sections related to motor vehicle renewals and title transfers were not extended and expire on July 25, 2020 at midnight.

#### **What you need to know:**

- **Pay March 2020 taxes by July 31, 2020 to avoid penalties.**
- **Pay motor vehicle renewals by August 31, 2020, if your registration expired in the months of January 2020 through July 2020.**
- **If you purchased a vehicle between March 16- July 25, you must transfer the title by August 24<sup>th</sup> to avoid penalties.**

The Page County Treasurer's Office is open to the public. A facemask is required for entry. **Driver's license remains by appointment only.** If you have questions or need to schedule and appointment, call the office at 712.542.5310
